The 12 tasks

- preparing food and cook a simple meal
- eating and drinking
- managing your treatments
- washing and bathing
- managing toilet needs or incontinence
- dressing and undressing
- communicating verbally
- reading and understanding written information
- mixing with others
- making decisions about money
- planning or following journey
- moving around
